

Somers Point Marina Storm & Inclement Weather Haul Out Service

Somers Point Marina (SPM) will remove, or haul-out, the Vessel from the water and store the Vessel on land according to the terms & conditions as follows.

Rates per incident:

- ≤36' L.O.A. \$14.50 per foot boat length overall (L.O.A.) to haul, block and launch the Vessel.
- plus \$1.30/ft. L.O.A./night storage charge. Storage while the Vessel is on SPM site, storage yard or marina: either in the water or on land.
- Optional Canvas and/or outrigger removal and reinstallation is available at is \$175.00/hr. + materials.

All charges are based on the boat length overall (L.O.A.) defined as the measurement in feet from the tip of the bow to the center of the stern, including bow pulpits, swim platforms, motor brackets and the length of the motors or outdrives in the raised position.

This service applies to any Vessel removed from the water up to 7 days prior to any storm or inclement weather. Vessels already on site for repairs and not retrieved within 48 hours' notice will be charged for storage.

This service is in addition to Winter Storage Hauling. If the boat goes directly to Winter Storage from this service only the storm & inclement weather haul/block/launch fee will apply.

Land storage may be on site (inside or out) or off site, outside at Somers Point Marina leased storage yards.

Vessel Launching will proceed as soon as conditions permit. The order of Vessel Launching will be dictated by the order the vessels were hauled.

There is NO guarantee requested services will be completed.

Payment is due prior to launch or upon vessel retrieval.

*Risk of Loss: Owner recognized that storage of Vessel, equipment and/or other items is at the Owner's risk. For Vessel's protection and owner's peace of mind, SPM strongly recommends owner remove all valuable items from Vessel. It is expressly agreed SPM will not be responsible for any loss, theft, destruction and/or damage of any items, nor for any loss, theft, destruction and/or other damage to Owner's Vessel or any other appurtenant to the Vessel or other equipment relating to any service provided by SPM. Owner does hereby indemnify and agree to hold harmless SPM, its agents, servants, employees, and representatives, from and against any loss, cost or damage resulting to Owner's Vessel and/or property, and/or other persons property. In no event shall SPM be liable to Owners', Owner's employees, agents, servants, guests, invitees, and licensees resulting from SPM's inability to act due to circumstances beyond the control of SPM, without limitation, any emergency, terrorist or other situation, or any act of God.

Somers Point Marina requires \$500,000 in Protection & Indemnity (watercraft liability) insurance including pollution liability for any boat on site. A copy of the insurance policy, listing SPM as additionally insured is required.

Somers Point Marina uses typical marine hauling, blocking and trailering methods. Owner shall not hold SPM responsible for damage resulting from a boat being structurally unsound for these methods of handling.
